
She has experimented with multiple languages and techniques: collage, engraving, digital art and sculpture, until she completely focuses on painting in 2014 when her research #chambres began.

Artist, largely self-taught, she began her pictorial study in an attempt to transform and translate unconscious impulses into shapes. A direct and instinctive language getting to the canvas unfiltered. Ilaria Bochicchio's bodies are closed in claustrophobic compositions. Each room is the place where these pieces of indolent flesh live, represented in their intimate abandonment. There is no anatomical description, but there's the pulse of limbs and muscles distorted and torn.

Her painting seeks a condition that reminds the sensation of human existence. The infinite layers of color are imprisoned by the final white veil, which, like a worn out skin membrane, lets you see the inside.

The bodies become a white chromatic mass soaked in color. The final draft is reached by brush and spatula strokes aimed at creating a sculptural physicality and a disintegration evoking anthropomorphic figures. The strength and intensity of color interact with light and create volumes that alternate in solid masses and liquid zones.

"A Vertical Reflection of thoughts and hints that metaphorically mark the stages of man's journey in search for the meaning of life. At first Colour – surface, questions. Then Shapes: research, commitment, choice. Then again Matter: answers, individual certainties". This artistic creation is an encouragement to reach awareness and test our limits, which represent the evolutionary heritage of society as a whole, trace the boundaries of change and disclose the future of mankind, defining the meaning of life and our own existence. The sculptures of the Vertical Reflection are 3D photographs of our instinct to grow, explore and improve. Spatial representations of lived lives, as the artist has imagined them, almost waiting for someone who will interpret and select them instinctively ... beyond reason... with a possession that is mental first, then real. Symbols that will become personal as soon as you see them. They get into your soul. Symbols that help us identify our place within Humanity. Our dimension. Unique. Powerful. Unavoidable!






Vertical Reflection, Miami 01 2016 Stainless steel mirror, wood, blue colour 50 x 50 cm


Giuliano Cataldo Giancotti

The artistic research of Giuliano Cataldo Giancotti stems from his deep interest in the human being, architecture and nature.

He is one of the pioneers among young Italian artists to use iron, which he prefers as a material par excellence of his creations. His artistic production consists of sculptures in the traditional sense, works that interact with luminous flows or three-dimensional landscapes that arise from the inspiration of travel sketches. His artistic research is currently directed towards the design of sculptures/architectures that reflect on the transformations of Italian architecture and give life to symbolic buildings called "Architectures of time".

The most interesting aspect of his works is the attention given to interiority, understood as the relationship between the human being and the intimate and continuous search for the self. An individual journey within oneself, in total honesty and without prejudices, to be able to aspire to an awareness, to be able to elevate spiritually and begin to conceive as part of the cosmos.





Her art is a celebration of the beauty inherent in nature and explore the contradictory simplicity and complexity of it, investigates its qualities of permanency and ephemeral, kindness and violence. Massimo Corona

In Massimo Corona's works, you can read the pleasure of the gaze lost into a city. The aerial view, so dear to the masters of the Renaissance, is examined by the artist's cards, defragmenting the image and distributing the movements of the paintbrush.


The use of two main color values – such as blue and orange, red and green, or green and violet – is linked to the optical and analytical dimension of work as a synthesis element that focuses attention on certain particulars of cities that become abstract motives, out-of-context, and then lost in the total as soon as you just leave the artwork. All this is realized through a careful search for balance and soft rigor, never shrill, but emphasizes that the synthesis process always corresponds to a loss, whether it is semantic or cognitive.

Currently he is carrying out a research that concerns painting from 1200 to 1500, with particular attention to the '400, to Flemish and French painters, but also to the painting of Giotto and Guido Reni. He analyzes the work of the Masters and realizes the studies using again the ballpoint pen's technique in two colors, then on the paper he crosses and stratifies the sign until completed images are obtained. The artist's intention is to reinterpret and bring back the Great Masters of the past.




Antonio Franchi's painting sets up a constructive and progressive dialogue, free from dogmatic techniques, between color and place. The site map is from Google Maps and Google Earth; a re-elaboration (the "aerial synthesis") is then developed, placing the color in the center of the work. The existence of the subject (the place) is only perceived, whereas color constitutes the means for evoking the place, at the same time constituting the essence of the work.

The color, pasty, flowing, invasive with its lighting effects, takes the place of things and evokes the specific place recalled in the title of the work, through the solicitations that memory and imagination of each one come to receive from the impressions given by the chromatic alchemies.

Lucio Tosi

As a painter, Lucio Mayoor Tosi has long created only digital art, and then, in recent years, he has approached a more traditional, abstract painting of informal derivation. "Much painting is born of rejection," he explains. "Toxins accumulated in these decades of absurd consumerism are expelled. Painting is thus emptying, a real weight loss therapy ». All this happens through the continuous experimentation of new materials, such as reinforced polystyrene, often of irregular size, on which today he paints preferring small formats. His compositions are essential, almost minimalist, characterized by emptiness, according to aesthetic principles of oriental derivation: often combined in multiple works, they are like stories fixed on a wall.



Ciro Strino's style is predominantly surrealist even if he does not abandon classical research on the greatest Masters of International Art history.







Michele Tombolini

Within Tombolini's body of work, paintings hold an important position since his youth. The works that he produces are in large format, almost seeking to contain the vital energy and the interior impulse that create, in contact with surrounding reality. From 2011 to today, Tombolini has focused on exploring the languages of performance art, installations and sculptures, aiming for the same all-engaging objective, expanding the limits of perception towards the three-dimensional. For more than twenty years, he has exhibited both in Europe and in the United States. In 2013 he was invited to exhibit at "Personal Structures", Palazzo Bembo, on the occasion of the 55th Venice Biennale.

During the last years, his artistic production has focused on relevant contemporary social issues, as can be seen also in a recent series of works strongly influenced by the artistic mood of Berlin. Issues such as child abuse and immigration, where the subjects are portrayed through the use of dull and opaque colors in contrast with the strongest and most accessible ones used in the background. Moreover, the black cross on the mouth is to highlight the censorship and the impossibility of communicating caused by our society's taboos. The final message, however, of all his works is positive: the wings are in fact indicating the possibility of taking flight and getting rid of a situation of hardship and difficulty.

Gian Pietro Bombardelli

Gian Pietro Bombardelli began to paint thanks to a small compensation for a claim. Not much money but enough to buy paintings, brushes, colors. The little treasure becomes a profession. A friend lends him a small basement as an atelier (where he still works) and he can finally be an artist. During the day he paints, at night he is a waiter in his Riva del Garda. But abstract works - which are absolutely original - do not sell. Anger then becomes a creative act. And here the touch of genius is added to what has already been expressed, but misunderstood: in destroying his paintings, Bombardelli "transforms" them.

Abstract pictures become conspicuous and capacious bags, resistant and colored and coordinated accessories. And the miracle happens: his creations end up in the window of a central boutique and success comes. These are "things" that appeal to them because unique pieces come from an art gesture that unexpected clients immediately catch in their unrepeatability. Thus - despite himself - the waiter also becomes a stylist. But before the transformation of his things takes place, Bombardelli puts in his paintings energy and color, pop inserts and incursions towards the abstract, collages that evoke a virgin and wild territory at the same time, a singular corner of the world inhabited by strange creatures, an abstract savannah to be explored.

He draws a lot and on anything. Comics, comics, comics...

His three children: Carlotta, Brando and Lupo drove him back on the paintings in 2005 and from that day he gave life to his instinct which have been suppressed for years ... the color! The characters that animate Mondorondo (the lovely planet without vocabulary!) live, breathe, they are made of pure color, they are iconic. In Mondorondo everything is made of fantasy and nowhere there's violence as the artist emphasizes. Aleandro Roncarà outlines his figures with sharp contours and robust blacks, the black lines become real exoskeletons of thoughts, they support the characters. They are funny and iridescent scaffolding, comes out from dreams and ideas, by the lyrics of songs sung at dawn, reaching the morning at the bar next door. He strongly believes in unusual color combinations and in black lines that separates them.

Five years ago he met the world of sculpture with considerable results. He collaborates with leading fashion companies, accessories, design and decor. He draw, he bakes cakes and paints in his one and only true "eternal" city: Montecatini Terme.

Angela A. Resina

Nina for the dogs was born from an idea by Angela A. Resina.

The project combines the passion for art, design and love for animals in a single author's creation. Inspiring muse and model for her creations is the little dog Nina, a cross between a Cirneco of Etna and a Pinscher, which Angela has adopted from a Sicilian kennel.

After various experiments and tests on the materials, the first samples in mixtures of resins and marble dust, white color, began. There are several pieces: each model is made by Italian artisan and are available in different surface finishes ranging from the most different colorings and effects such as those in gold, silver, bronze and the completely transparent one reaching the most precious version with the coat in golden leaves.

In addition there are many collaborations with great Italian artists, artists of different extractions and trends, who with their talent have reinterpreted and embellished the collection through the creation of unique and original pieces. Each of their works, belonging to the Nina Art Collection, is signed and certified and represents a piece of Italian history to which the artists themselves participate with momentum and enthusiasm.

Nina, the small design dog, is therefore not an industrial product, but a valuable work to admire and collect completely Made in Italy. Owning a Nina means appreciating beauty, tradition and values. Moreover every Nina realized contributes to the support of Teg 4 Friends Onlus, a voluntary association present in eastern Sicily that protects, takes care and promotes the adoption of abandoned dogs.

Emanuel Bullita

The Emanuel Bullita's philosophy is at the base of what he is.

Creativity comes from inspiration, inspiration comes from curiosity, curiosity allows you to observe, and observe allows you to see. His path is the result of research, readings and thoughts that change and change over time, always bringing out new works.

His collages are unique creations, always different and with a strong visual impact.

The choice of the subject takes shape only during the execution phase, while the paper, with different textures and porosities, is strictly taken from newspapers, magazines and fashion catalogs. Through the cropping and the assembly of the image, everything passes between the hands of the artist who can thus also insert his own sensations into the work.

For backgrounds, however, he goes in search of the same color tone, for example the black one: based on the weight, the composition of the color itself, the images printed behind that color and the glossy/opaque finish, he selects and makes up the base, which it will be black, but thanks to the different type of paper, it will create a chromatic diversity and a unexpected image depth.

His creations are for a spectator who pays attention to the different forms of expression, does not stop just looking but will try to see and see, in the different subjects, evident traces of the personality of Emanuel.
