ITALY ERECTS IRON MAN STATUE TO HONOR TONY STARK'S NOBLE DEATH IN AVENGERS: ENDGAME

e're not crying ... you're crying! In **Spider-Man: Far From Home**, we got a glimpse of just how big a martyr **Tony Stark** (Robert Downey Jr.) had become in the MCU after he nobly **sacrificed himself** to defeat Thanos (Josh Brolin) at the end of **Avengers: Endgame**. Just as murals were eventually painted to remember the selfless Marvel hero in Tom Holland's second **Spidey** film, life is now imitating art in our reality ... with even more art.

Man created by artist Daniele Basso in order to commemorate the hero's cinematic death. Named "Man of Steel" (yes, we know it's a bit confusing what with Superman and all), the sculpture is a touching tribute to the character in his classic superhero landing pose. Standing atop a large marble block in the seaside town of Forte de Marmi, the figure is made of bright stainless steel and brass. The inscription that goes with the piece loosely translates into:

"The first monument dedicated to Iron Man in the year of his cinematographic death celebrates Tony Stark, the man who used his great wealth to fight for the ideals in which he believed ... reminding us that we are the protagonists of our era. That the future of humanity depends on our decisions ... that all of us must be heroes!"

"Art, for me, is an opportunity to communicate important messages through beauty. The opportunity to remind us of our individual and collective identity. To stimulate consciences ... Superheroes talks to the child we always have in our souls. They remember us the sense and the meaning to do the right thing," Basso tells SYFY WIRE. "I like the Tony Stark character, who is not always right. [He's] a man with his imperfections, but uses all his influence and power to help others. So I wanted to remember this, which is my vision, the reason I choose Iron Man to send this message to the community. ... I wanted to remember, [even] in the wonderful and luxury of Forte dei Marmi (and in the crazy and funny Italian summer) the importance of our choices and behavior in everyday life."



The statue first began with a drawing from Basso, who then developed it further with a 3D computer program. From there, he had to build the 13-foot thing by welding together two metals that are very hard to bind to one another, even with heat. In fact, a brand-new process had to be developed in order to make the project a reality. That added an extra six months to the end date, which was literally years in the making. Sadly, Marvel was not involved in any stage of the statue's fabrication.

"This project comes from my personal passion for Avengers movies. And most of my friends are very passionate about comics. I took inspiration, emotion, and information from them about this wonderful world," adds Basso. "Iron Man was perfect to express the message I wanted to share: 'We all are heroes in ordinary life, and we must do our best to preserve our world and the values we believe in for the future we want to live in.' Today, when communication is so fast and problems are becoming more and more global, we need to know who we are to better understand where we want to go. Not just to follow the others. Our opinion is important, and we need to know that, and to exercise it."

A picture of the statue was originally **posted on Reddit**, but its details were confirmed to SYFY WIRE by Gianmarco Cantinotti, head of marketing and communication for **Principe Forte de Marmi** a five-star hotel in the Northern Tuscan city. Part of an exhibition entitled "Oltre Verso," *Man of Steel* will remain in the town until this coming Sunday, Sept. 8.



At this time, there are no plans to bring the exhibit to the U.S., but Basso is hoping he can show it off in Lucca, a town in Central Tuscany. He's also not opposed to making more statues of other Marvel heroes, but wants to stress that even with the epic depictions of comic book characters seen in things like *Endgame*, regular folks like us are the only ones who can really save the day.

"Yes ... why not?!" he concludes. "At the end [of the day], heroes are going to save the world in fancy [ways]. But we are able to save our world in real life."


You've Got to See This! Iron Man's 'Avengers: Endgame' Death Honored with Impressive Italian Statue



Marvel fans are pretty passionate—you can look to the uproar over the recent Spider-Man/MCU news as proof. (Not to mention that *Avengers: Endgame* is now the highest grossing movie of all time. That's proof too.)

With the demise of so many beloved heroes in MCU movies over the last year or so, naturally fans are grieving. Perhaps most of all, that grief has been directed to the loss of Tony Stark/Iron Man, whose standalone 2008 movie kicked off the entire MCU. As such a stalwart character, Stark went on to become a valuable leader within the Avengers, and his influence has certainly remained strong within the MCU; for instance, his death played a role in *Spider-Man: Far From Home*, particularly the way in which Peter Parker strove to live up to his mentor's legacy.

In addition to Far From Home, the loss of Stark has elicited tributes from around the globe. And one of them is extraordinarily epic. As shared by Krypton Radio, a statue honoring Iron Man in his classic landing pose has appeared in the Tuscan town of Forte dei Marmi in Italy, titled, ironically, "Man of Steel."



Apparently, the piece was made of steel and glass polished to appear mirror-like. Created by artist Daniele Basso, the statue appears as part of an exhibit called "Oltre Verso," which opened last month.

The figure also possesses a plaque lauding Stark, which reads:



The first monument dedicated to Iron Man in the year of his death in the cinematic world, we celebrate Tony Stark as a man who dedicates his life's fortunes to fight for the ideals he believes in ... reminding us that we are all the protagonists of our time – that the future of humanity depends on our decisions ... that all of us must be heroes!





Italian Town Pays Tribute to Iron Man By Erecting Statue








Iron Man made the ultimate sacrifice in Avengers: Endgame and some fans are still reeling from losing their favorite hero. One fan in Italy wanted to make sure that no one forgot Tony Stark's fictional sacrifice. Daniele Basso created an Iron Man statue that stands on a slab of marble in Forte de Marmi. The sculpture is called "Man of Steel," despite being a work lionizing Iron Man, and captures the hero making his signature superhero landing from the first movie.

"The first monument dedicated to Iron Man in the year of his cinematographic death celebrates Tony Stark, the man who used his great wealth to fight for the ideals in which he believed..." The inscription reads, "Reminding us that we are the protagonists of our era. That the future of humanity depends on our decisions ... that all of us must be heroes!"



Such a proud statement seems to effective eulogize Stark after the fateful snap that saved the Marvel Cinematic Universe. Using his fortunes to fight for the betterment of mankind fits in with the company's version of Iron Man. Just like in <u>Spider-Man: Far From Home</u>, the hero lives on as a symbol of hope and the human spirit.

Basso told SYFYwire, "Art, for me, is an opportunity to communicate important messages through beauty. The opportunity to remind us of our individual and collective identity. To stimulate consciences ... Superheroes talks to the child we always have in our souls. They remember us the sense and the meaning to do the right thing."

"I like the Tony Stark character, who is not always right. [He's] a man with his imperfections, but uses all his influence and power to help others. So, I wanted to remember this, which is my vision, the reason I choose Iron Man to send this message to the community ... I wanted to remember, [even] in the wonderful and luxury of Forte dei Marmi (and in the crazy and funny Italian summer) the importance of our choices and behavior in every day life," he concluded.



Robert Downey Jr's Avengers hero Iron Man memorialised with Italian statue





Robert Downey Jr's Iron Man kicked off the Marvel Cinematic Universe as we know it and in Avengers: Endgame, he sacrificed himself for the greater good.


But his Tony Stark will live on forever, not just in our memories and our DVDs but also as a statue that has been erected in Tuscany, Italy.

Designed and created by artist **Daniele Basso** as part of a month-long exhibit called Oltre Verso, the statue is part of a 40-piece collection in the town of Forte Dei Marmi.

Basso named the statue — which features Iron Man in his classic three-point landing pose — Man Of Steel, not to be confused with **DC Comics** hero Superman, who is also known under the same moniker.

The plaque which runs alongside the statue is in Italian but translated reads: 'The first monument dedicated to Iron Man in the year of his death in the cinematic world, we celebrate Tony Stark as a man who dedicates his life's fortunes to fight for the ideals he believes in... reminding us that we are all the protagonists of our time — that the future of humanity depends on our decisions ... that all of us must be heroes!'

Taking to Instagram, artist Daniele added: 'Iron Man is alive and well...and he is in Forte dei Marmi!!



'Iron Man has a magnetic heart, but I have a sensitive artist's heart! And the enormous appreciation I am receiving for my sculpture thrills me!

'Thank you all and remember: the future of humanity depends on our choices...all of us must and can be heroes!'

Endgame is thought to be Downey Jr's last outing as Iron Man with the MCU moving into phase four which will focus on the new guard of Avengers including Black Panther and Captain Marvel.

However the upcoming launch of new streaming service Disney+ will allow for more Marvel stories to be told, and it has been reported that Downey Jr will return as Tony once more in a voiceover capacity for rumoured new series Ironheart.

Ironheart follows Riri Williams, the teenage genius who continues Tony's legacy in the comics, and according to We Got This Covered their source alleges that the company has got Downey Jr on board to voice Tony who will appear as an AI — similar to Paul Bettany's J.A.R.V.I.S — and will help her train to become a superhero.

It stands on Via Carducci in the town, near the Piazza Marconi, with a plaque explaining the thinking behind the piece.



We know we say this a lot, but there's fresh proof that this really *is* Marvel's world and we're just living in it. In yet another case of life imitating Marvel Cinematic Universe art, Italian sculptor, Daniele Basso, has taken a page from the many Iron Man murals that populated *Spider-Man: Far From Home* and paid tribute to Robert Downey Jr.'s fallen Avenger in a new monument that made its debut as part of the Oltre Verso art exhibition in the Tuscan seaside town of Forte Dei Marmi. The artist shared images of his creation on Instagram recently, and fans are already loving it 3000.

Cheekily entitled "Man of Steel" — a reference to Iron Man's Distinguished Competitor in the DC Extended Universe — the sculpture preserves Tony Stark's classic three-point landing in all its metallic glory. Basso sculpted Iron Man's image out of mirror polished steel and glass. A plaque that accompanies the piece speaks of Downey's alter ego in the most glowing of terms.

Nelle scorse settimane, infatti, a **Forte dei marmi** è stata inaugurata la mostra dell'artista **Daniele Basso** intitolata *Oltre Verso*: oltre a una serie di statue in metallo realizzate dallo scultore e mostrate alla galleria del Fortino lorenese, in via Carducci si può osservare anche un vero e proprio monumento che richiama il modo inconfondibile in cui **Tony Stark** atterrava sulle ginocchia e col braccio alzato quando dotato della sua armatura. La posa dell'eroe è realizzata con la tecnica del **metallo specchiato e frammentato** tipica dell'artista in questione.

di Piero Lombardi – Nelle scorse settimane l'artista Daniele Basso nella mostra intitolata Oltre Verso, ha dedicato una scultura ad Iron Man, l'opera: Man of Steel ritrae la figura di un uomo che atterra sulle ginocchia con il braccio alzato, tipica posa di Tony Stark, l'eroe degli Avengers.

La scultura è realizzata attraverso la tecnica del metallo specchiato e frammentato, già utilizzata dell'artista, ai suoi piedi la targa recita:

"Con il primo monumento dedicato ad Iron Man nell'anno della sua morte al cinema celebriamo Tony Stark come l'uomo che ha dedicato la fortuna della sua vita alla lotta per gli ideali in cui credeva, ricordandoci che siamo tutti protagonisti del nostro tempo, che il futuro dell'umanità dipende dalle nostre decisioni, che tutti noi dobbiamo essere eroi".

E' la prima volta che il personaggio interpretato da Robert Downey Jr viene rappresentato con una scultura, in passato abbiamo visto **Capitan America a New York**.

È comparso a **Forte dei Marmi**, in via Carducci, vicino a Piazza Marconi, incorniciato da un radioso tramonto. Venerdì 9 agosto 2019, con una cerimonia ufficiale, in presenza delle autorità locali, è stata inaugurata la mostra antologica "Oltre verso" di **Daniele Basso**, che insieme alle opere esposte fino all'8 settembre al Fortino Lorenese, include una curiosa installazione site-specific: un omaggio a **Iron Man**, appositamente realizzato dall'artista.

Icona pop legata al mondo dei fumetti e al Marvel Cinematic Universe, congedata con la "fine del viaggio" di Avengers: Endgame, Iron Man/Tony Stark ha incollato allo schermo un'intera generazione di

L'opera, ha spiegato l'artista biellese a Toscana Today, ci ricorda che "tutti noi combattiamo una battaglia e **dobbiamo essere eroi**". Sul basamento in marmo che sorregge la statua è stata infatti apposta una targa con dedica che recita queste parole.


