Marina di Carrara, September 30th 2021. The Italian Sea Group chooses art to highlight the uniqueness of Tecnomar for Lamborghini 63 gifting to all the Owners of the iconic yacht a sculpture realized by artist Daniele Basso, "Vrumm Bang Bull".

Vrum Bang Bull is a bull made out of resin with a base in mirror polished nautical steel (35x21cm, 21cm) which will be bestowed to the yacht's Owners at the moment of the vessel's delivery. TISG has chosen this work by Daniele Basso, who often exhibits his creations inside the Shipyard, due to the aesthetic affinity with the characteristics of both the yacht and the cars, as well as the material with which it is realized.

Art has always represented a fundamental element of TISG's philosophy. In Marina di Carrara, contamination through artistic codes is at the forefront and is expressed throughout the collection of pieces scattered throughout the Company's Headquarters. Bor on 4/8/1975 in Moncalieri (TO), Daniele Basso is an Italian artists known for his works in mirror polished stee. Pieces that provoke a higher knowledge of oneself in the search for our identity. He participated to three edition of the Biennale d'Arte di Venezia, with exhibitions and works in different parts of the world, including Carrousel du Louvre (Paris), Università del Seraphicum (Vatican City), GNAM (Rome), Expo 2015 (Milan), World of Coca Cola (Atlanta), Officine della Scrittura (Turin), Museo del Parco (Portofino), Shoah Memorial (Milan) and in galleries in New York, Dubai, Saint Petersburg, Tel Aviv, Monte-Carlo, Lugano, Milan, Turin and Bologna. In 2015 "Coke Its Me" (The Coca-Cola Company) and Gigant (SWC Alta Badia – Unesco Park Dolomites). In 2017 he was awarded at the 67th Sanremo Festival for Star Team Monaco (HRH Prince Albert II of Monaco) and for Inter FC. In 2019 he was the Main Artist at Andrea Bocelli's Teatro del Silenzio, directed by Luca Tommassini. Today, his works are present in Artion Gallery, Galerie Sept, Simon Bart, Hysteria Art, Laura Tartarelli Contemporary Art and Galleria Ferrero.
