## Salone del Mobile, tra arte e design con numerose presenze dal Biellese

In corso, fino a domenica, nei padiglioni fieristici di Milano-Rho, la grande kermesse del Salone del Mobile, con 20.10 aziende presenti e alcune significative presenze biellesi, sia all'interno dell'esposizione che nelle iniziative cosiddette "fuori salone". Ci sono nomi importanti, come quello dell'artista Michelangelo Pistoletto, che ha presentato la sua iniziativa "Coltivare la città" rappresentata da un campo agricolo di 750 metri quadrati allestito sul tetto del Superpiù Studio di via Tortona, naturalmente ispirato al concept del Terzo Paradiso.

C'è anche la grande azienda biellese della moda Ermenegildo Zegna che, insieme alla comunità di San Patrignano, nell'ambito di "Barrique, la terza via del legno", propone Baco, il progetto che ha dato vita a una collezione di oggetti ricavati da legno di recupero nei laboratori della comunità di recupero, sotto la guida della designer spagnola Patricia Urquiola.

L'architetto Luisa Bocchietto partecipa al Salone sia nel suo nuovo ruolo di direttore editoriale della rivista di settore "Platform" che con un progetto di allestimento per Bitossi Ceramiche, sia, al Fuori Salone, alla mostra "Milano Makers" alla fabbrica del Vapore, con "Lamiaitalia", prodotto realizzato con Ceramica Gatti e alle performance di Sketch your City oh Hope di Villa Busca Serbelloni.

## Daniele Basso: successo italiano a New York

Aprile è senza dubbio il mese della qualità del design e dell'arte italiana se da una parte Milano è stata animata dalla design week in occasione del **Salone del Mobile**, anche oltreoceano la firma italiana ha fatto parlare di sé. Il 23 aprile infatti è stata inaugurata a New York, nella prestigiosa **Galleria Ca' d'Oro** situata nel vibrante quartiere di Chelsea, la personale dell'artista **Daniele Basso**, esposta insieme alle opere della scultrice americana **Dalya Luttwag**. Tra le altre prestigiose opere, **"Achilli"**, metafora sulla rapacità intrinseca dell'essere umano, capace tanto di sorvolare le cose quanto di farsi catturare dai particolari in un dato momento; **"Les Plis De La Vie"**, presentata alla 55° Biennale di Venezia e dedicata alla crisi come momento di sfida e crescita; **"Web Pop Icon"**, un'indagine della condizione di arma a doppio taglio del web; e infine il quadro specchiante **"Russian Atmosphere"**, presentato in occasione della **Design Week 2014 di San Pietroburgo** - di cui Daniele Basso fu la special guest - e metafora della solitudine che interessa ogni individuo, sia egli solo o in gruppo.

Se siete a New York non perdetevi questa mostra che offre non solo una panoramica delle opere dell'artista ma anche una profonda riflessione sui temi fondamentali che accomunano tutti gli abitanti del pianeta.



Daniele Basso started his activities in the Milan fashion setting, cooperating with Gianni Versace. He gained expertise in communication with Publicis, as well as in design with Versace Group, Ermengildo Zegna, and FIAT Auto, working in both New York and Paris. In 2006, he founded GlocalDesign, a strategic design office whose motto is Think Globally, Act Locally. GlocalDesign focuses on fashion, interior design, and lighting design. Driven by a keen curiosity for mirrored steel surfaces, he first started significant partnerships and projects with various renowned Italian design brands including Krizia, Moncler, Napapijri, Milla Schon, Molteni & C, Swarovski, SanPatrignano, Italamp, Slide, and the Federico Fellini Foundation. Basso started working as an artist in 2010 and participated in Venice Biennale International Art Exhibition twice. He has exhibited his works in New York, Paris, Dubai, Lugano, Monte-Carlo, Forte Dei Marmi, Vatican City, Milan, Bologna, and Naples. His works can be seen in several permanent collections, including the Portofino Park Museum, where "We=Wall" (a section of the Berlin Wall in mirror-finish steel) is displayed. In 2015, his collection "Vertical Reflection" and his sculpture "We Have a Dream" was displayed at Galleria Ca' d'Oro New York. Also in 2015, his sculpture "Coke It's Me" was commissioned by Coca-Cola to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the iconic Contour Bottle.

### VERTICAL REFLECTION




*The most exciting cities today are hopelessly vertical. Vertical emotions of daring shapes in concrete, glass and steel,  
where nature struggles to the surface, living creatures climbing great heights to survive...*

"Vertical Reflection" is a collection of steel, felt, and wood. It explores vertical modernity meeting horizontal tradition; fast-paced fashion versus the paralysis of conventions; and the boundary between private and public dimensions, trends, and beliefs. Basso has described the collection as "a vertical reflection of thoughts and hints that metaphorically mark the stages of man's journey in search for the meaning of life. At first color: surface, questions; then shapes: research, commitment, choice; then matter: answers, individual certainties." Basso intends these works to encourage awareness and test our limits, which represent the evolutionary heritage of society as a whole, trace the boundaries of change and disclose the future of mankind, defining the meaning of life and our own existence.

Dalya Luttwak's sculpture explores the subterranean support systems that anchor and nourish the plants that we cultivate, harvest, and admire. Since 2007, Luttwak has expertly forged, hammered, welded, and painted steel — transforming the rigid metal into intriguing artworks that evoke the sinuous forms of roots. Working from actual physical roots, which the artist often draws in all their complexity, Luttwak seeks to uncover the hidden beauty of roots, exploring the relationship between what grows above the ground and, more mysteriously, what grows below. Her sculptures, in essence, reveal what nature prefers to conceal. Luttwak's work has been exhibited both nationally and internationally, most notably during the 54th Annual Venice Biennale, the American University Museum at the Katzen Arts Center, and The Kreeger Museum in Washington, DC.



Daniele Basso, A.B.A. (Italy & USA) and Design (Milan) graduate (his thesis is at Carrousel du Louvre, Paris) with a Communication Master, he starts working in Paris and NY (Gianni Versace) and in Milan (Publicis and Fiat Auto). In 2006 he finds "GlocalDesign" that cooperates with the major brands of Italian Design (Molteni&C, Silde, Italamp, MilaSchon, Swarovski, SanPatrignano, Beko, Unicredit). In 2009, his artworks are on display in NY, Turin, Naples, Verona and Milan, followed by an array of exhibitions and collaboration around the world.

After a tour of events in USA Including NYC, Seattle, Atlanta and Miami In October he starts his cooperation with Novalis Art Gallery with his solo exhibition "Vertical Reflection", set in the Gallery Space and dedicated to Hong Kong.

### Fire Power in Chelsea

APRIL 20TH, 2015 by Jean Lawlor Cohen



Dalya Luttwak knows metal, from her days as a goldsmith/jewelry maker to her current sessions bending steel red-hot from a furnace. Years ago, with small-scale, wearable designs, she showed, for example, at the Renwick Gallery, the Smithsonian's museum of fine craft in Washington, D.C. Now, Luttwak works in an industrial mask, large-scale and in steel, shaping heavy, forged rods with hammer and welding torch.

As if in a nod to her history, gold elements appear in the elegant tangles of "root sculptures" installed April 23 through May 24 in her exhibition, *Roots: Nature's Hidden Beauty*, at the Chelsea outpost of **Galleria Ca' d'Oro**. Luttwak credits this fascination with roots to an act of nature: a tornado that upended a silver maple onto her car and revealed the tree's hidden beauty. But why steel? The very fact of its difficulty, she says, and the connection it shares with roots. Her material, too, emerges from earth, extracted as iron ore that returns as rust.

Some ascribe to these botanical abstractions a *metaphoric* significance—buried feeling and memory or the unconscious self. Others, however, respond to roots' *formal* qualities. Critic Barbara Rose, for one, relates their aesthetic to "the intertwined skeins" of a Pollock, "ganglia" or "barbed wire" and finds in the torque of these sculptures a movement from aspiration to power.

Luttwak's monumental installations have achieved high visibility in such contexts as the U.S. Botanic Garden, towers of the Arsenale during the 54<sup>th</sup> Venice Biennale, a tennis court at Washington, D.C.'s Philip Johnson-designed Kreeger Museum and soon the 18th-century façade of Sicily's Guttuso Museum. Yet even here, in a domestic-scale gallery and illuminated as single objects, her subterranean presences assert their mystery and splendor.

Also on view: *Reflections*, geometric and mirrorlike sculpture by Daniele Basso. Both exhibitions open with a reception April 23, 6-8 p.m.



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
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
